

2009 Rocky Mountain Summer Slide Futurity Conditions

Division Offered: Open, Intermediate Open, Limited Open, Non Pro, Limited Non Pro

The futurity will adhere to NRHA rules with the following additions:

1. Eligibility for the futurity will be limited to foals of 2006. This is an NRHA approved event.
2. Horses may be shown two handed in a NRHA legal snaffle or hackamore or one handed in any NRHA legal bit at rider's discretion.
3. The Open divisions of the futurity will be run separate from the Non Pro divisions of the futurity. The first go will be Thursday and the finals scheduled for Saturday.
4. Contestants must enter the Open division to be eligible to enter the Intermediate or Limited Open divisions. Contestants must enter the Non Pro division to be eligible to enter the Limited division. Only one \$50 judges fee will be required for cross-entries. Cross entries must run in both the open and non pro divisions.
5. In the Open and Intermediate Open divisions, the top 25% of entries but not less than 30 head in the Open Division and not less than 15 head in the Intermediate Open Division will return for the finals based on first go scores. A minimum of 25% or a minimum of 12 entries will return in the Non Pro division. This is a clean slate finals.
6. In the Limited Open and Limited Non Pro divisions awards and paybacks will be based on the first go score.
7. All prizes for all divisions will be awarded Saturday afternoon, after scores have been verified.
8. Paybacks will be awarded 40% on the first go and 60% on the finals. It is a clean slate finals.
9. RMRHA will retain 40% of entry fees.
10. **Entries are due July 7, 2009.** Late entries will be accepted with a \$75 per horse late charge until 1:00 p.m., Wednesday, July 22. The draw will be posted by 6:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 22.

2009 Rocky Mountain Summer Slide Stallion Stakes Futurity Conditions

Divisions Offered: Open, Non Pro

The Stallion Stakes will adhere to NRHA and RMRHA Futurity rules with the following changes:

1. This is a NRHA approved event.
2. In the Open and Non Pro divisions, the top 25% of entries will return for the finals based on first go scores. A minimum of 20 entries will return to a clean slate finals in the Open Division and 12 in the Non Pro division.
3. RMRHA will retain 40% of entry fees.
4. **Gelding Incentive:** A special gelding incentive will be paid to the high scoring gelding in the Stallion Stakes Open (\$500) and the Stallion Stakes Non Pro (\$250) Futurity. High score can be achieved in either the first go or the finals, not a composite score.
5. The get of the following 2006 enrolled stallions are eligible to compete as three year olds in the 2009 Stallion Stakes Futurity:
