### General Show Conditions & Information

**Stalls:** A total of 28 aisle front sponsor stalls are available and will be sold at \$375 each on a first come first served basis. All sponsor stalls MUST be prepaid. Aisle front stalls **ARE NOT** available except as listed above. Sponsor stall purchasers will receive:

- ☆ Banner space in the main arena. Banner to be furnished by sponsor.
- ☆ VIP parking pass outside of west doors (one per purchased stall front).
- ☆ One year listing on the RMRHA website as a Summer Slide Sponsor.
- ☆ Special thank you listing in the RMRHA membership newsletter.
- ☆ Announcements throughout the horse show as an event sponsor.

**Regular Stall fees** are \$150 for the entire show or \$40 per night. Feed and bedding available for purchase on the grounds.

**Office Charge:** There is a \$20 office charge per head for all horses entered in any class.

**Arrival and Check-In:** Arrival on the National Western grounds is absolutely restricted until after 12:00 p.m., Sun., July 25.

**Host Hotels: Double Tree Hotel,** 3203 Quebec St, 303/321-3333. \$112/night. Make reservations by June 25 to receive the above rate.

**Red Lion Central,** 4040 Quebec St., 303/321-6666, \$79/night. Make reservations by June 25 to receive special rate. **Make reservations early as there are a number of events taking place in Denver during the week of Summer Slide. Be sure to tell the hotel you are with the Rocky Mountain Reining Horse Association to receive special show rate.**

**RV Hookups:** A limited number of hookups are available. Electric only at a cost of \$20 per night. Due to the limited number of available spaces, **reservations are strongly encouraged** and will be assigned on a first come, first served basis. Contact show secretary to reserve spaces. Hookup fees will be added to your show tab. Pump out service will be scheduled half way through the show and will be added directly your show tab (estimated cost \$40.) All spaces, 30 amp.

**Dogs:** No dogs are permitted on the National Western Complex grounds. The City and County of Denver Code Enforcement Officers are able to write tickets to owners for any dogs found on the grounds of the National Western Complex.

**This show will adhere to NRHA rules with the following additions:**

**1. Entries for all classes each day will close at 5:00 p.m. the night before (except futurity classes, see futurity conditions). Exhibitors submitting entries after any announced closing time for any class, whether the draw has been posted or not, will draw their own working position (first or last). No phone entries will be accepted for any class.**

**2. Show tabs will be put in the name of the legal owner according to the name listed on the competition license. Government 1099 forms will be issued accordingly, unless specified otherwise at the show. Premium checks will be issued in the name of the responsible party as listed on the show tab. No changes to 1099's will be permitted after the last day of the show. Social Security number or tax I.D. must be provided to the office.**

**3. Stallion, Gelding and Mare Class Rules:** Horses entered must be of the correct gender. Any horse may be shown only once. May be ridden one handed or two handed in any NRHA legal bit or NRHA legal snaffle or hackamore. No training equipment allowed in the arena. This class will have a live person in the chair but will not be scored. **Five minute time limit to be timed by announcer & exhibitor will be excused from arena at the end of allotted time. No phone entries will be accepted.**

**4. The Kyle Wood Perpetual Memorial Trophy** sculpted by C.R. Morrison is awarded to the highest scoring youth exhibitor showing in either age division of the youth class. This award is sponsored by the **Dave Belson Family** in memory of their grandson Kyle.

**6. Little Kids Reining Guidelines:**

- a. A pattern will be posted for this class.
- b. Limited to kids ages 5 through 10.
- c. Adult may assist, leading horse through the pattern is acceptable.
- d. Fan involvement encouraged; judges may give extra credit for large fan club noise.
- e. Kids entering short stirrup class are not eligible for Little Kids Reining.**

**7. Payment for show tabs will be accepted in the form of cash or negotiable check. A \$50 fee will be added to all short checks.**
